My concerns are simple. I do not oppose the Park, even though I live close to

the area at 39351 e Colonial highway, directly across from Eric Hall who is

the closest neighbor. I also own

39345 e Colonial.

I would prefer not to have anything there, but a sports field is certainly

preferable to another housing development.

I simply want to be protected as much as possible. This means leaving all of

the trees on the WEST end of the park as they are now. I understand that plans

now call for these trees to remain as is. But I have had bad experiences in

the past when the plans called for trees to be untouched but some eager contractor went ahead and did his thing anyhow.

All anyone could say after that is "whoops." So please make an extra effort

to be sure that the contractors hired to do the job are impressed with the

need to leave those trees.

My second concern is night time lighting. I would like to see at least the

levels of control at Franklin Park be applied to this park as well.

Add my vote as a neighbor who wants the lights limited as much as possible.
