


Dear Mr. Phillips:

Per your request, Patton Harris Rust & Associates, (PHR+A) has reviewed our February 18, 2009 report and have provided the following supplemental descriptions of the existing roadway conditions to satisfy the County's F.S.M. Traffic Study Guidelines, per our December 3, 2008 scoping meeting:

- **(11) Safety Locations:** – *Road safety hazards as identified by ISTE A set-aside funding criteria and/or identified by the County at the scoping meeting, within the study area ...* No safety hazards are identified within the study area. East Colonial Highway has identified curvature below the 55 MPH speed limit east of Canby Road, but the curvature is marked with advisory signs at 35 MPH. Speeds are reduced approaching the Town, adjacent to the site frontage. Sight distance is limited at the Va. Route 9/Business 7 T intersection at Dry Mill Road associated with the Rte 699 curvature looking east, which is reflected in the higher vehicle stopped delay for the southbound to eastbound left turns. The turns have an existing stop condition.

The additional clarifications would be best reviewed as part of the VDOT 527 study under existing conditions (page 13) and do not change the conclusions or technical analyses, so a full submission is not proposed. Please accept this letter as a supplement to accept the application. The full copy of the report and CD as submitted had been delivered to your attention this week. If you require additional materials for your review, please advise. Thank you in advance for your consideration of this project.
