

Dear Mr. Schneider:

On behalf of our client, DC Water, we hereby request that SPEX 2009-0040, Potomac Interceptor Odor Abatement Site, be withdrawn. Following review of the first submittal of the subject application, Brian Fish, Zoning Administration, determined by comments dated March 26, 2010 that the Odor Abatement Facility is a public utility facility that will be accessory to the existing Dulles Interceptor sewer line. Proffers associated with ZMAP-1986-0013 state "that land which is dedicated to the County or NVRPA at the County's discretion shall be subject to necessary utility and stormwater easements and other easements as necessary to serve the subject property". As the existing sewer line, and therefore the proposed Odor Abatement Facility, are serving the subject property and are located within the existing sanitary sewer easement, no Special Exception is required for the Odor Abatement Facility to locate within the PDH-4 Zoning District
